## COUNSELLING PROCESS FOR GUBEDCET 2018

There will be seat matrix for all B.Ed. colleges based on their intake capacities. In the seat allocation, the reservation policy of the Government of Assam would be followed, which will be: OBC- 15%, SC-7%, STP-10%, STH-5% and PWD-3%.

The merit list will be prepared based on 30% weightage on UG or PG examination marks, whichever is higher and 70% from the GUBEDCET 2018. The 30% marks has already been printed in Admit Card. If any false information is detected in the marks submitted by a candidate, the candidature of the candidate will be summarily rejected. The calculation of percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in the UG or PG will be done up to 4-decimal places.

In case of a tie in the cumulative total (i.e. UG/PG weightage + GUBEDCET 2018 weightage), the following steps will be taken to break the tie in order to determine the Rank of the candidate step by step until the tie is broken:

- a) The candidate securing higher marks in the 30% component (i.e. UG or PG examination marks).
- b) Seniority on the basis of Date of Birth.
- c) The candidate securing higher percentage of marks in the HS (10+2 level) examination.
- d) The candidate securing higher percentage of marks in the HSLC (10 level) examination.

Results will be declared in the following Lists of Candidates with upper limit as stated:

(i)	Open list	:10000
(ii)	OBC list	:1500
(iii)	SC list	:700
(iv)	STP list	:1000
(v)	STH list	:500
(vi)	PWD list	:300

The result of GUBEDCET 2018 will be declared on **10/08/2018**. The Rank List will be declared on **17/08/2018**.

There are 37 colleges affiliated/permitted to conduct the B.Ed. course under Gauhati University. Candidates will select their preferred college from the list of B.Ed. colleges from **11/08/2018** to **15/08/2018**. A candidate may select a maximum of 37 B.Ed. colleges, but must select a minimum of 1 (one) B.Ed. college. A candidate will not be considered for admission without selection of preference(s). Candidates are to ascertain the pedagogy/method subjects, fee structure and other facilities available in the B.Ed. colleges (from their websites) before giving their preferences.

The process of counselling will consider allotment of seat from Open and Reserved category lists on merit basis in the following steps and sequence:

1. Pick up candidate in 1<sup>st</sup> Rank, then check whether a seat is available (if he/she belongs to reserved category, the candidate will be considered first in open category) in the college of 1<sup>st</sup> choice made by the candidate. If the 1<sup>st</sup> choice college has no vacant seat, then admission in the 2<sup>nd</sup> choice college will be considered. The process will continue till the last choice.

If no choices are available, then the candidate will not be assigned any seat in this counselling process.

2. Step 1 will be continued with next Rank candidate till all seats are filled.
3. First list of candidates against each college will be published on **21/08/2018**.
4. A candidate may take admission on or before **24/08/2018** in the allotted college. Once admitted, the candidate will not be allowed to transfer college. However, if a candidate is not satisfied with the allotted college, he/she must report to the particular college and should fill up the **FLOATING** form which will be available in the respective college. The candidate has to pay a security deposit of Rs.10000 in the University Account through payment gateway which will be adjusted against the admission fees of the college where the candidate will finally take admission. University will transfer the money (after deduction of Bank Charges as applicable) to the respective college account after receiving admission statement from the college.
5. The name of candidates who do not report to the college by 24/08/2018 in person or through representative will be **DELETED** from the selection list and will not be considered for future counselling.
6. The list of admitted candidates will be displayed on **25/08/2018**
7. The vacancy list in each college will be displayed on **25/08/2018**
8. The second counselling will start with the FLOATING candidates and the remaining candidates in the list. While filling up seats in the second counselling the steps at 1 and 2 will be followed.
9. Second list will be published on **29/08/2018** and candidates will have to take admission on or before **30/08/2018**.
10. The list of admitted students will be published on **31/08/2018**.
11. The vacancy list, if any, in each college will be displayed on **31/08/2018**.
12. There will be counselling in person and admission for the remaining vacancies, if any, on **02/09/2018** in Gauhati University.
13. No B.Ed. college under GU shall be allowed to admit any candidate who has not qualified in GUBEDCET-2018 for the 2-year B.Ed. course for the session 2018-19.
14. Classes for new session will start from **04/09/2018**.
15. For any matter not covered under the above, the decision of Gauhati University will be final and binding.
16. Seat allocated in each B.Ed.College after admission of Teachers deputed by the Govt. of Assam.
